- Kids get to take care of the tank, feed the sea life, perform salinity and temperature checks, monitor, record and eniov
- Kiersten has been taking care of tank for 10-15 years and over the years it has provided many opportunities for children both in caring for the sealife and connecting to fieldtrips to teach children to be active in their communities.
- -Encourages children to become citizen scientists and can link to community initiatives such as testing the water in the pond to determine if pollution is a cause for the lack of frogs in the school pont
- -Provides opportunities to create movies and other schools have a Go Pro mounted to tank to stream live feed (magnified) as a teaching tool for kids
- Staff and EAs find value in it intial set up was \$6000 and yearly cost is \$1500. Go Pro camera \$529 with mounting


