What is Child Alert? Child Alert is a volunteer run program that ensures your child has arrived safely in their classroom every day. This is accomplished through communication between a 24hr in school answering machine, email, your child's classroom teacher, main office sign-in book, and the child alert volunteer.

What is Child Alert's main goal? To ensure your child's safe arrival at school.
