Stay Home When Sick

All parents and caregivers have the responsibility to assess their children daily for symptoms of COVID-19, the common cold, influenza or other respiratory infectious diseases before sending them to school.

Preparing for the day at school

- Complete a health check of all children coming to school every morning
- □ Be prepared for the weather and to be outside during the day
- Pack a lunch with containers and packages students can open on their own, 'pack in and pack out' all of your food waste and garbage
- □ Fill water bottles for the day school fountains are currently closed
- Use a good pair of shoes to be able to run and play for the day

Drop Off and Pick Up at school

- All students will enter and exit the school through their classroom outside door
- Drop Off time is between 8:40 am and 9:00 am
- Students will line up outside their classroom outside door on the marks
- Students wash their hands every time they enter and leave the classroom
- Pick up time is between 2:30 pm and 2:48 pm
- Parents line up on the marks outside classrooms to pick up
- □ Students walking home will be dismissed at 2:48 pm
- □ If students show up late please go directly to the classroom outside door
- Parents must stay outside unless going to the Office through the Main Doors
- □ If you need to access the Office use the main doors only or call 250.479.4014

Staying safe while at school

- □ Practice physical distancing and respect people's personal space
- □ No hugs or high fives keep your hands to yourself
- Do not share items with other students like pencils, felts, toys or food
- □ Wash your hands with soap for 20 seconds
- □ Cover your mouth and face when you cough or sneeze
- Try not to touch your face, especially your mouth, nose and eyes
- □ Use the washroom outside your classroom and walk on one side of the hallway
- Do not go past the markers in the hallways
