The savings provided is an immediate contribution to your fundraising efforts.</i></p> <p><i>Any active grants to your organization under the current program format will be in effect until June 15, 2021. To maximize earnings for your organization, encourage your cardholders to load their existing Fundraising Smile Card. The 5% contribution is based on the total amount loaded on to the card. Funds earned will be paid out in full after June 15, 2021. Organization representatives will then transition to purchasing Smile Cards in bulk at a discounted price from the store of your choice.
